TWC travels to Colorado Springs, Colorado

Anja Gardziola, John McHaney and Jacob McHaney are currently in Colorado Springs, CO training with Master David Bartlett in preparation for the 2011 National Championships to be held in San Jose, California June 28th-July 3rd.

David Bartlett, brother of Mrs. Kim and Miss Bartlett, is the current US ARMY Tae Kwon Do team coach for the World Class Athlete Program. He is also an assistant US National Team Coach for USA Tae Kwon Do.

Eight members of TWC will travel to San Jose for the Championships!

David Asbury, Gregory Gardziola, Gabriella Gardziola, Concetta Gardziola, Anja Gardziola, John McHaney, Jacob McHaney and Logan Maitland-Smith.

Seven of the eight competitors competed last year in Orlando, Florida.

This will be Jacob McHaney's first year competing at Nationals in the 14-17 year old division. He competed earlier this year at the US Open.

This will be David Asbury's last year competing as a color belt in the 14-17 year old division. He will compete as a Black Belt beginning September 2011.

Concetta, competing in the 41—50 year old division and twins Gabbie and Gregory, competing in the 12-13 year old division, will all be looking for medals this year!

Logan Maitland-Smith won the event last year in the 10-11 year old Black Belt division. This will be his first Nationals competing as a 12-13 year old.

John and Anja both placed 3rd last year in the 14-17 year old division. This is their final year to make the Junior National Team. A medal this year earns them a spot at the Junior National Team Trials to be held July 30-August 5th in Colorado Springs. They will both also be competing in the 18-32 year old division!

Their teammates will be rooting for them all week!! Chris Connor, Conner Caples, Aiden Miller, Claire Gyomory, Nicholas Crews, Brendyn Heim, Byron Heim, Randy Crews, Gray Ashworth, Caroline Ashworth, Gressette Holt and Scott Holt.
